





Imagery - visually descriptive or figurative language




I and You

Beat 2 – Anthony is just a bunch of dots, he is not real, but there is a connection between the two characters




Beat 3 – This is all about the project and understanding the meaning of the project



Beat 4- They start to actually get to know each other, feels like a first date, and there are sparks between them




Beat 5 – The project starts to grow, and we start to see a path of them growing together




Beat 6 – Both characters look like they are shutting the door, but neither truly have shut the door



Beat 7 - Reality is starting to make more of a presence, but it is still distorted




Beat 8 – The connection between the two is there in full force now
